INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

Abstract

Submission All authors of oral and poster presentations must submit an abstract, together with a registration form, to the Secretariat by e-mail. Submission by fax will not be accepted.

*Please note that as a result of session arrangement by the program committee, your paper may not be assigned for the Poster / Oral session according to your request.

Abstracts will appear in the abstract book to be distributed during the Workshop.

Format Prepare an abstract of A4 size paper (one page) in PDF format. The abstract should contain title of the presentation, names of authors, affiliation, e-mail address of the presenter, the abstract text and three keywords. All abstracts should be made following the attached example (font type, size etc). No pictures or graphs should be included in the abstract.

File name must consist of the presenter's name, underscore (_) and either orl (for oral presentation) or pst (for poster). Please make sure to include the proper extension in your file name ".pdf". Example: Ishimatsu_orl.pdf (oral), Ishimatsu_pst.pdf (poster) *If you have difficulty in converting to a PDF file, please contact the Secretariat.

Extended Abstract

Submission All extended abstracts must be submitted electronically to the website of the Workshop (in preparation). All authors of oral presentation must submit one extended abstract.

Format Prepare an extended abstract of A4 size paper (4-5 pages) in MS Word (not PDF) format. The extended abstract should contain title of the presentation, names of authors, the abstract text and three keywords. All extended abstracts should be made using the template which you can find on the website (in preparation).

Full Paper manuscript for submission to the Journal of Oceanography

The local committee of the 2007 ECS Workshop decided to submit selected papers to Journal of Oceanography. The *Journal of Oceanography* (JO) is one of ISI journals with the impact factor of 1.060 (2006), edited by the Oceanographic Society of Japan. Its scope encompasses a wide range of issues relating to the oceans. The local committee wishes to publish five to eight papers in JO to make a special section for the Workshop. Those who wish to submit their manuscripts to JO are requested to state their interest at the time of abstract submission (by September 30, 2007).

Submission Interested authors are encouraged to contact the Secretariat for submission. In order to process manuscripts according to publication schedule of the special section, the local committee will set several deadlines.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ORAL SESSION PRESENTERS

Presentation language is English. The allotted time for each presentation is 15-20 min including the time for questions and discussion. Speakers are requested to bring a USB memory stick containing your presentation file. Both Windows and Macintosh machines will be available for your presentation. If you

bring your own notebook computer, please note that Japan operates on 100 volts for electrical appliances, with a cycle of 60 Hz in Nagasaki. The plug type in Japan is A with two flat blades. File name must be your family name and affiliation (e.g. Ishimatsu_Nagasaki).
